

### *Eucharistic Ministers Needed*

Both parishes are looking for additional Eucharistic Ministers. If interested please submit your name to Fr. Tim. There will be a training for New Eucharistic Ministers on Thursday, April 30th at 7:00 p.m. at Blessed Sacrament. This is a very important ministry and you are asked to consider whether you are being called.

*From the Pastor:*

At first glance the story of the apostles may seem incredulous. One might think that after Jesus has appeared to them once that they would catch on that he had been raised from the dead. The gospels indicate that each time Jesus appears the apostles usually do not recognize him. When they do they are filled with fear and joy. Last week's gospel of doubting Thomas starts with the end of the gospel of the two on the road to Emmaus. As they are telling the others how they recognized him in the breaking of the bread, Jesus stands before them and again the apostles are startled, terrified, think he is a ghost. We might say or think, oh my, are they dense or what?

But the more I thought about it I began to see their story as mine and possibly ours. The question that crossed my mind was; do we always recognize the presence of God in our life? Do we always recognize the action of God in our life? For me, I would have to say no. Then the more I thought about it I wondered if some of us are still Thomas doubting that God is active in our life, that he manifests himself in various ways and that he is truly trying to guide us to the fullness of life.

Some of us may have recognized something as being the intervention of God but have failed to recognize him in other things. Some, like me, may have come to realize how active God is but still miss times that are truly directed by or are a gift of him.

So I began to feel that the story of the apostles was not as farfetched as I was thinking. One of the things that St. Ignatius recommended was that during the day people take time to look back on the life just lived to recognize the times that a manifestation of God may have been missed. He does not suggest that as means to feel guilty, but as a way to become more aware of where God has been and to be alert to his presence in the future.

The journey for us is like the road to Emmaus. It is one from despair to hope, death to life, grief to joy, turmoil to peace. As Jesus said to Thomas, "do not be unbelieving but believe." Where are we on this journey; unbelievers like Thomas, just not getting it like the others, getting sometimes but not all? What is the answer? It takes time, reflection, prayer, and asking for help.


