Dear Friends,

There are some of you who have a direct experience of St. Patrick's in Millerton since you go there every Sunday for Mass. When I first came to our parish, I had no experience with a "mission" (a mission is a satellite or branch Church connected to a parish Church usually with a Sunday Mass celebration).

We recently determined that this is St. Patrick's 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary (founded in 1864, it's even older than Immaculate Conception).

We are in the process of planning a celebration in September, a special Mass that will be held on Sunday afternoon, probably on the 14<sup>th</sup> at around 2 pm. Please put this on your calendar. We always should honor our buildings on special days, because we know they are more than buildings; they are people from the past and people from today, worshipping God and helping each other, expressing the love of Jesus every day. We also, in a very real way, honor those who have gone before us as we honor St. Patrick's, since our beloved deceased are buried around that beautiful Church. It is especially important, during this era of Church closings, to thank God for our parish and to continue to support them with all our hearts.

I ask all of you, if you have any information with respect to the history of St. Patrick/s or have any documents relating to the mission, to bring them to me. It will be very helpful in commemorating our special "mission", St. Patrick's in Millerton.
