My Friends,

As Lent is fast approaching, it is time to think about ways of deepening our faith life. Again this year, we will have a Cluster Parish Mission beginning the Sunday evening of March 9th. Through different presenters, we will prepare ourselves for the diocesan-wide celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Wednesday, March 12th. While more details will follow, it is a good time to reach out to friends who have not been active in the practice of their faith and invite them to participate.

On the Tuesdays of Lent (except for the Parish Mission on March 11th), the Evangelization commission is sponsoring a program known as *Awakening Faith*. During the Tuesdays of Lent, parishioners are invited to gather and share a meal. The meal is followed by input on a relevant topic of faith and personal faith-sharing with the group. I highly recommend your participation in this program as a way to renew and deepen your life of faith.

On Thursday nights, the Elyria Ministerial Association as part of its initiative to promote Elyria as a **'Compassionate City'**, will be reading Karen Armstrong's book, *Twelve Steps to a Compassionate Life*. Each week they will discuss a few chapters from the book. Mayor Brinda presented a resolution to City Council on making Elyria a 'Compassionate City' and the Council passed the resolution. It is all about raising our consciousness about extending compassion to one another. This would be a great first step in pursuing this initiative.
