My Friends,

Beginning tonight here at St. Mary's, our cluster Parish Mission will focus on the need for reconciliation in our lives and our world. It will prepare us for the diocesan celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Wednesday night. If you are unable to do anything else for Lent this year, I would really encourage you to participate in this mission. We are working to promote our Elyria community as a 'Compassionate City.' The work of reconciliation begins with the self. Our consciousness of sin awakens in us the need for redemption. Once we untie the knots and open our hearts to receive God's grace, compassionate living can begin. We begin to walk in the shoes of others rather than pursue our own selfish preoccupations. The disciplines of Lent foster this outward perspective. When we fast from our own self-absorption, we see the needs of the poor and suffering and respond through almsgiving. This is not just money, but as Pope Francis encourages, with our time and service. If sin is usurping the role of God, our prayer life puts things back in perspective as we reconnect with the source of all we have and are.

Our Lenten theme is: 'If today you hear his voice, harden not your hearts.' It is a wonderful mantra taken from Psalm 95 that we can repeat throughout our day. It can help us to bring the awareness of God's presence into our daily lives. There are numerous opportunities offered in today's bulletin to deepen your faith and spirituality. On Tuesday's we have 'Awakening Faith.' On Thursdays we have the community book club reflecting on Karen Armstrong's The Twelve Steps to a Compassionate Life. This is an ecumenical and citywide effort. This Thursday, we will be meeting at Wesleyan Village, 807 West Avenue. The Second Step, "Look at Your Own World," and The Third Step, "Compassion for Yourself" will be discussed. On Friday we have the Stations of the Cross at 1pm and 7pm. There are bulletin inserts and copies of The Word Among Us to assist you with your daily observance and reflection. A family recommendation would include a trip to the movie theater to see the movie, 'Son of God' and talk about it as a family.

Today we will be sending our catechumens and candidates to St. John's Cathedral to celebrate with Bishop Lennon their *election* as they prepare for full initiation into the Church at the Easter vigil. Please keep the following in your prayers: Candidate - Tanya Marie Meyer and Catechumens - William A. Jordan, Chayton Ashton Clark, Marc Anthony Clark, John Logan Autra, Benjamin Tyler Lauren and Kayla Elizabeth Hess. We look forward to their joining us at the table of the Lord.

One last footnote: the Diocese of Cleveland is presently researching the best way to communicate with the faithful of Cleveland. Some of you will receive a survey in the mail. I encourage you to fill it out and return it. We need to find out how best to spread the good news of the gospel. Your insights will be most helpful if finding out how you get your news.
