

FROM FR. KEN:

At the parish, we tend to get quite a bit of mail. Sometimes it is interesting to see what comes in. There are important things, like a letter from the bishops office with a stamp across it that says "confidential", bills, donations, the Afton Star Enterprise, or a letter from a bank addressed to "Spirit Halloween" asking us if we need a small business loan at 30% interest, or the pounds of catalogues that come in. Yet, it is still kind of exciting when the mail comes in to see what is in it. Is it going to be something that we immediately throw into the recycle bin, or is it going to be something that is of great importance. Sometimes we can just look at an envelope and know what it is, but other times we are surprised, I once received a letter from a gentleman and an old picture postcard of Holy Spirit Church, he said that he had found it in an antique shop (he also asked for \$5 to cover the cost and postage.) How many times in our lives do we do the same with people? We know who they are and we are sure what they want or want to say to us, and we are correct most of the time, but the other times, we are surprised by them. I had an experience of a man who was shabbily dressed and had a beard come up to me and talk. I was sure that he wanted some money, but when he started talking, all he wanted was for someone to listen to him. In the end, he reached into his pocket and handed me three \$1 bills and said, here is something for the church, Father. When you ignore the mail, you could miss a check or a bill that needs to be paid, when you ignore someone, you could miss an opportunity to help.


