

# FROM FR. KEN

Can you believe that Lent is half-way over? As we used to say in seminary, the days are long, but the weeks are short. This week we break out the rose or pink vestments again as a celebration that we really do rejoice in the Lenten season, even through our fasting. This Sunday is called Laetare Sunday from the entrance antiphon which states Laetare Jerusalem or rejoice O Jerusalem. Our celebration of Laetare Sunday is to give us hope through our fasting. So, how is the fasting going? Is it getting easier or harder? Either way, it will soon come to an end when we can celebrate the resurrection. The purpose of fasting is to increase our self control so we can be better at moving away from sin. Sometimes the desire to do what we are fasting from gets pretty strong and we fall into the temptation, but the key is to get back up and to start over again. One of the phrases I use quite often, when I catch myself doing something wrong is "sorry about that Lord, let's move on." The immediate asking for forgiveness and not wallowing in the guilt is something we need to do, the guilt we have for doing something wrong is not to make us feel bad, but to help us to remember to not do it again. If we put our hand on the stove it burns and hurts, the pain is to tell us that we are harming ourselves and we need to move our hand away from the stove. Guilt tells us to move away from those things we are doing that are harming ourselves or others. Lent is the time in which we can work on those things so that we can move toward the resurrection of Jesus Christ, so Rejoice that the Lord is coming again.
