

FROM FR. KEN

What is your mission in life?

During these weeks in the Easter season, the first readings are all about mission, the sending and mission of the Apostles, mostly on the travels and preaching of St Paul and St Barnabas. They have been sent by Jesus to go out and travel the countryside proclaiming the Gospel (good news) of Jesus Christ. They had this particular mission to do this and some, but not all, of their travels and experiences are recorded in the Bible. While they had a mission, each and every one of us have a mission from God, we simply need to find it. As we are creeping up on the graduation season, we often hear the question to the students about what they are going to do after graduation, or what do you want to be when you finish? The best question for students as well as for adults, is what is our mission in life? Each of us has a mission that God is calling us to, for some it is tied to our job, but for others, it has nothing to do with how we "make a living." Mission is something far greater than just a job, it is all about where God is calling each and every one of us to be. Paul and Barnabas were called to spread the Gospel in a particular way, we are called to spread it in a different way. Where do you see God calling you to spread His message? If you don't know, ask! Spend some time in prayer each and every day to ask God where you are being called today and in the future. It does not have to be going out and preaching on the street corners, it can be done in the simple ways, by being open to talk about faith, by learning more about it, or simply by treating all people like Christ.


