

FROM FR. KEN

After the Eucharistic Prayer ends, it moves into the Communion Rite which begins with the praying of the Lord's Prayer. Sometimes I get asked about how we hold our hands for the Our Father. The priest holds his hands extended in what is called the orans posture, but there is nothing specified for everyone else. It is a later addition that the people follow this position and even later that people began to hold hands, the position in which we pray is entirely personal and I ask that if someone does not want to hold hands that we should not take offense at it. The priest then prays a doxology and then the people continue with the prayer reminding us that the prayer is for glory to God. The priest then offers the peace of Christ to all the people and then invites us to offer that peace to each other. The reason that the priest does not go into the congregation to shake hands is because the sign of peace has already been offered and received with the previous interchange. The priest then mingles the Precious Body with the Precious Blood as a reminder of unity with the Bishop. Then it is presented to the people and consumed by the priest, and then each of us with a clean heart receive the Body and Blood of Christ. Remember within the Church it is an option to receive the Body of Christ on the tongue or in the hands, always mindful of WHO we are receiving. The vessels are purified and we then conclude with the prayer after communion and a blessing over the people and a final call or sending. The word Mass itself means to send. We then sing a recessional song as the priest recesses out of the church. The Mass is the source and summit of our faith and an incredible closeness with God Himself.


