

FROM FR. KEN

This weekend is a big one for the second graders of our parishes. They are receiving Holy Communion for the first time! For a while, they have been preparing themselves to receive Jesus into their bodies in a very special way, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This is what we receive each and every time that we receive Holy Communion. As we witness these young people receiving Jesus Christ for the first time, we should always be reminded of the incredibly special thing that should happen as we receive Jesus ourselves. We may have received Holy Communion thousands of times in our lifetimes, but we should always be reminded of how special it is to do this each and every time. Some of the great stories about the saints revolve around the reception of the Eucharist in their lives and how they allow Jesus to change them. We hear the phrase "you are what you eat" so if we eat the Body and Blood of Christ, we will be transformed into an "Alter Christus" or another Christ. We get caught up in the children dressing so nice, the boys with ties, the girls in their pretty white dresses, yes, it is a special day for them, it is a very special and holy event. But, as special as the first time they receive it is not less special as the 4,000th time or even the last time. Some of the incredibly powerful things I have witnessed is someone receiving Holy Communion when they know it will most likely be the last time they will receive it on this earth. What would happen if we receive Jesus each time as if it was our first and last time we will receive Him, how special that would be, to be reminded each and every time the wonderful gift Christ gave us in the Holy Eucharist.

It is a weekend of celebrations! We have several young students who are receiving the Body and Blood of Christ for the first time and we are honoring high school graduates at St. Edward Parish.


