

FROM FR. KEN

With first Communions coming up, (Saturday the 7th for Holy Spirit and Sunday the 22nd for St Edward) it is good to look at our own selves as we receive the Blessed Sacrament. For a while now, these children have been preparing themselves to receive Jesus into their bodies in a very special way, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This is what we receive each and every time that we receive Holy Communion. How do we think of it when we are receiving it? Are we reminded how special of a thing it is to be able to receive Christ and let His body and His blood feed us, both bodily and spiritually? This is an important day in the children's lives as well as their families. We get caught up in the children dressing so nice, the boys with ties, the girls in their pretty white dresses. It is a special day. It is a very special and holy event. It should be an incredible experience. But, as important as the first reception of the Eucharist is, the 2nd, the 10th, the 323rd, etc is not less special or important for any of us. We sometimes forget how special it is to receive the Blessed Sacrament on a regular basis, as the old saying goes, what we do daily, sometimes we do dully. I invite each and every one of you to remember your own First Communion (I received mine from Fr. Pat Bacon). Remember how special that day was and what it meant to you. Is receiving Jesus today, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity less special today since it is not the first time? Take time again and again to remember how special it is and to receive Him each and every time we come to Mass. The first time is special, but so are all the rest!


