

FROM FR. KEN

It seems hard to believe, but there is only a week of school left. Things move really fast! As we plan our fun time for summer, remember to keep thanking God each and every day, especially on Sundays. When traveling, remember to check when Mass times are going to be for the weekend, what better way to thank God for the ability to travel, than to spend an hour with Him on Sundays. There is a great website called masstimes.org that will tell you where all the Catholic Masses are in a particular area, they even have an iPhone and Android app! For example within 18 miles of the center of Orlando, there are 30 Catholic churches with almost 100 Masses ranging from 4:00 to 7:00 on Saturday night and from 7:00am to 6:00pm on Sunday. If you are going on a cruise, some cruise lines have Sunday Mass, as well as, daily Masses, offered on the ship, and if you are going to Rome, just walk across a street and find a Catholic Church, there are only about 900 in the city. If you are in a larger city, consider attending a Mass in another language, like Spanish, German, French, or Latin. While you will not understand the words, you will still know what is going on because of the common Mass. Another consideration is to maybe try a Catholic Mass in a different Rite, in Orlando, there is a Byzantine Rite Catholic Church and if you have never been a part of an Eastern Rite Church it is a beautiful liturgy and one you will remember. If there really is no way to get to Mass, bring up the readings for Sunday Mass and spend some time as a family reading over them and discussing them. Remember, even during vacations, to spend time thanking God for the love and mercy He gives us.
