## FROM FR. KEN

As I am writing this article, it is four years to the day that I arrived here at Holy Spirit and St Edward. I remember how nervous and excited I was to move, I was looking forward to another year as an associate pastor and again using the phrase "have you asked the pastor about that?" It was challenging to leave Corpus Christi Parish and St Albert School, but I am really happy here as well and when the time comes for me to move, I will face some of the same challenges. As I have been reflecting on the last four years, I remember, while there have been some challenges, there has been many more wonderful things that have happened since I have been here. Here at Holy Spirit and St Edward I have had the wonderful opportunity to celebrate 1,500+ Masses, 66 baptisms, 14 weddings, 86 funerals, and confirmed 20 during the Easter Vigils. When I was preparing for my ordination seven years ago, I told myself that I would go where I was needed by the diocese and not necessarily where I wanted to go, because I did not want to get in the way of the Holy Spirit working in my life. As we wind up the graduation season, my advice to those who are either graduating or making changes in their lives, is to be open to where God is leading, guiding, and sending. When we are open to where God is leading us, we can do some wonderful things, but we do need to be open to it. When we are open to where God is calling us, we can be led to incredible places and do some amazing things for our own lives and the lives of others.
