

FROM FR. KEN

On July 21st, one of my favorite professors from seminary was named a bishop by the Holy Father. Now bishop-elect Robert Barron, a priest of the Arch-diocese of Chicago, is going to be an auxiliary bishop for the Arch-diocese of Los Angeles. He has a wonderful website called Word on Fire or wordonfire.org where he speaks to a number of topics and issues. I also thought that I would talk about the process of what is involved in naming or becoming a bishop. The basics are that you need to be someone who is outstanding and solid in faith, good morals, have a zeal for souls, a priest ordained for at least 5 years, and be at least 35 years old with an advanced degree. The Pope, is the one who in the end names men to be bishops, but there is a lot of input from others. According to the Church Law (Canon Law) the bishops of each region should compose a list of priests that they feel would make good bishops. This process is to be done confidentially and is then sent to the Pope. This list is sent to a committee who will look into each one on the list and see what they have done. They will contact the current bishop of the diocese and a couple of other people in the diocesan offices and find out some more information about this person. They will even sometimes send a confidential letter to other priests in the area to find out more about the particular person. If after investigation they find the priest acceptable, then the committee will send the information about the priest to the Holy Father along with the diocese that he is being recommended to serve as bishop, and he will make the final decision as to whether or not name the priest a bishop.


KNIGHTLY NEWS
