

FROM FR. KEN:

Are you holding to your New Year's Resolution? About 60% of Americans will make a resolution for the New Year, and after two weeks, over half of the people will have already broken it. Some of the top resolutions are to lose weight, cut down debt, quit smoking, staying fit, spend more time with family, get organized, and live life to the fullest. While all of these things are good goals, something that can help us in all of these, is to increase our relationship with God. One of the keys of success to achieving any goal is to have something specific and obtainable, to say I am going to lose weight or pray more does not give us something specific, but is kind of fuzzy and thus hard to follow. Sometimes we have to just set some time aside or plan on doing something. I set aside time in the morning, afternoon, and evening for prayer, now sometimes something else interferes with those times and the prayer time gets changed, but I try and hold to those times. Each and every one of us can do something similar, while we are all busy people it does not take a lot of time to say a few prayers of thanksgiving, blessings for someone, for strength, wisdom, or whatever we need or are grateful for. We can just put a number or word in our calendar just to remind us to pray and spend a few minutes with God. It can be for 5 min to say a decade of the rosary, getting up 10 minutes earlier, turning the radio off in the car and praying while we drive, while we sit in our car eating lunch, or for half an hour at the church, whatever time we have Even Jesus went alone to pray, let's use that example of his prayer to guide us in our prayer life.


