



We are again coming up to the Solemnity of All Saints. The feasts of All Saints and All Souls are important feast days for us as Catholics. We celebrate these days in order to remember those who have gone before us to eternal life. While they are similar in the fact that we are celebrating those who have died, they are different in what we are praying for. For those that are in heaven (All Saints) we pray a prayer of thanksgiving, one that is also asking those saints to pray for our needs. For those who are not in heaven yet, those who are in purgatory (All Souls) we are praying for their needs, that God will speed the time of their purgation of sin and bring them lovingly into the kingdom of heaven. Within the Church we have two different kinds of saints, the first and most known are the named saints, these are the people that the Church has publicly stated have lived their lives in a way that they have received God's grace in the kingdom of heaven. The more common and numerous, but less know are the countless number of people who have also received the reward of heaven. When someone dies that we love, we should pray for them, that they will receive the rewards of the kingdom of God, but one day, and we will know when, our prayer should change from praying for someone, to praying with them. God will sometimes give us a sign of when that can happen. Each and every one of us should strive to be celebrated on the feast of All Saints, because this day is one in which we honor those who we may not know that have entered into the kingdom of heaven. 
