

# FROM FR. KEN

For the Year of Mercy, Pope Francis is going to have the Holy Doors in Rome opened. There are seven designated Holy Doors throughout the world: the four major basilicas in Rome, one each in Spain, France, and Canada. What happens is, that if we do the prayers and come through the doors, there is a plenary indulgence granted. A plenary indulgence is something that God grants us because of His grace and mercy alone, it is not something we earn by doing the steps and it is not superstitious. To go along with the pilgrimage to the holy doors, the Holy Father has asked that the indulgence become more accessible. He has asked each of the diocese to select churches to designate a holy door, and within our diocese, Bishop Pates has recommended that each region of the diocese do this, and Holy Spirit in Creston was selected for our region. I have chosen the door next to the confessional as that door. On November 22<sup>nd</sup> this door will be sealed with a prayer and blessing at the end of Mass, and then reopened on December 13<sup>th</sup> at the end of Mass with its designation as a place for pilgrimage and were we can receive this plenary indulgence. We will keep that door closed and locked during those few weeks. We will also be getting some prayer cards to use with the year of mercy and the holy door. With this honor, there will be people coming from the churches in the area for a pilgrimage to the holy door. So as we prepare ourselves to begin this Year of Mercy, I would invite each of us to look up some of the many scripture passages in which Jesus shows us the mercy of the Father, because the mercy we show to others, will be shown to us.


