

FROM FR. KEN

Blessed Advent! This weekend we begin the Advent season. The First Sunday of Advent is officially the new year for the Church. We switch to a new set of readings again from year C to year A which includes going to the Gospel of Mathew. This week though, we begin again with Jesus reminding us to be ready. In the second reading from Paul's letter to the Romans, it begins "Brothers and sisters; you know the time; it is the hour now for you to awake from sleep. For our salvation is nearer now than we first believed" I sometimes hear people tell me that we are in the end times and the end of the world is near! Yes, we are in the "end times" and we have been for 2,000 years. When Jesus told His Apostles to be ready because He was coming again, that was the beginning of the end of time, the end of the world, but He does remind us that we will not know the time in which it will come. Will the end of the world come, YES, will it happen tomorrow, I don't know, only God does. What I do know is that we need to be ready when it comes. The Advent season, similar to the Lenten season, is a season of preparation for the second coming of our savior, as much as it is a preparation for the remembrance of the first time He came. Take some time in this new Church year and time of preparation to see where we are being called to be ready for the coming of Christ again. As St Paul continues to "Let us then throw off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light" the light that Christ is for us.



CCW DUES


