

FROM FR. KEN

The sacrament of Reconciliation or Confession is one that I discuss quite a bit, because I think it is one of the most underutilized sacraments. During the seasons of Advent and Lent, we tend to be more focused on getting ourselves ready, which means also getting our hearts ready and one of the best ways is to cleanse it with this great sacrament. I sometimes hear that someone is embarrassed to say what they have done, but what if we were more embarrassed to sin, than we were to admit it. The sacrament can and is one of the most powerful helpers for us. In the rite of major exorcisms for the Church one of the things that it HIGHLY recommends is to celebrate the sacrament before attempting to perform an exorcism, because the devil cannot use any confessed sins against the priest, simply because what God has forgiven has BEEN forgiven. Another thing I have heard is that I can't think of any sins I have done. Really... then you are not truly looking at your life. Pick up a good examination of conscious and pray over it for a while, I will guarantee that each of us can find things that we have sinned at. The most common overlooked one is gossip or detraction and there is a difference, gossip is something that may or not be true and detraction is something that is true but should not be spread. Most of the time when we do not feel that we get anything out of whatever we are doing, it is because we are really not putting much into it. During this Advent season, I am adding some extra confession times to go along with the regular ones. Take some time in prayer to see what Jesus is calling you to leave behind in the sacrament and then continue to work to work on


