FROM FR. KEN:

Sometimes there is a great reaction to how we greet people this time of year, we hear Happy Holidays (the word holiday comes from holyday) and even though we like to say Merry Christmas, it is not yet Christmas, it is Advent. When we say Merry Christmas what we really mean is I wish that you would have a Merry Christmas when it comes. The word Christmas itself comes from the two words put together; Christ's Mass. When Christmas is written, we sometimes see it written as x-mas instead of Christmas. The word Christmas comes from Christ's Mass, the Mass that we celebrate each and every week. When we see it written as x-mas some people think that we are "X"ing out Christ. But it is shorthand for the first letter of Christ in Greek (χριστός Christos.) Within the Church you will see an overlapping XP which is the chi (X) Rho (P) those are the first letters for Christ these are often flanked by the A (alpha) and Ω (omega) first and last characters of the Greek alphabet to represent Christ being the beginning and the end. So in short, X-Mas was just using the X as shorthand for Christ. Also while we know that Mass refers to the celebration of the Holv Eucharist, it comes from the Latin word Missa which means dismissal, sending, or mission, it also refers to the Holy Sacrifice that Christ Himself offered for us. Jesus Christ's mission in this world was to bring us to the Father and that is why He came. When we say Merry Christmas we remind people to have a joyous remembrance of the sacrifice God Himself gave to us, and it should be joyous, so when someone says to you Happy Holidays, just respond with love, peace, and joy Merry Christmas to you as well.




QUESTION OF THE WEEK
