

FROM FR. KEN

I have been asked a question, since Christmas is on a Monday and Christmas Eve is on Sunday, does that mean I have to go to Mass twice. The answer is YES, yes you do! Mass on Saturday night or Sunday morning does NOT count for Christmas, and the Christmas Masses beginning at 4:00 on Christmas Eve, do NOT count for Sunday. I hear sometimes the slogan "Keep Christ in Christmas" also how about keeping Mass in Christmas. We should live our lives to say we get to go to Mass multiple times instead of I have to go to Mass. The entire reason for Christmas is the celebration of the coming of our Savior as a child, through the Blessed Virgin Mary, this should draw us to the celebration of the Eucharist. No gift any person can give us can even come close to the gift we receive when we receive the Body and Blood of Christ, the entire reason we celebrate Christmas. In many ways, I think that we have lost Christmas to either the materialism of the shopping, or to simply a time to spend with family and friends. While giving and receiving gifts is not a bad thing, it is not the primary thing in Christmas, just like it is not about a rotund guy in a red suit, and while taking that time to spend with family and friends is a wonderful thing, it is not the primary reason for Christmas. The primary reason for Christmas is the fact that God loved us so much that He chose to come down to the earth and to live our life from a humble and helpless child to also die a death for our salvation. So, this week, as we continue to prepare our hearts and minds in this Advent Season for the coming of our Savior, take the time to be reminded of the Christmas story in the Gospels.

DIACONATE ORDINATION



BEGINNING EXPERIENCE





Question for Children: As we get closer to Christmas, name one thing you really want for your home or the world such as peace, friendship, or food for the poor.


Question for Youth: John tried to help people prepare their lives for the coming of the Messiah. What do you need to change about your life to be ready for Jesus' coming?
