

FROM FR. KEN

This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday! It is a very popular Mass, in fact it is on average the third or fourth highest attended Mass and I am sure that this year will be no different. The kick-off to Lent is actually a wonderful day, it is a day of fasting, a day of prayer, and is often a time to reflect on our lives. When we decide what to give up, we need to remember as I say every year, it is a penitential act for ourselves and not for those around us. Lent is that solemn preparation time in which we get ready for the holiest days of the year, the celebration of the passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord and Savior. It is also a season in which we often take some time and look at our lives. Hopefully we will do that and then consider doing something for Lent that will help us to change. I would highly encourage everyone to try and give up something different than the standard chocolate, soda, or snacks. Try something hard but will help us to really grow. Try giving up some time and give it to God, it can be as simple as taking half of our lunch time and going off and praying, turning off the TV for half an hour, or make it a point to stop off at the Church for ten minutes every day after work to pray, or we could give up gossiping or complaining. There are so many things that we can do instead of just giving up chocolate. Try something unique and different this year, maybe even make it a family effort to either give up something together or to do something for others as a family. Remember the three pillars of Lent: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving and let these be your guide for this blessed season.

LENT BEGINS WEDNESDAY

- Check the Mass schedule to the right for Mass times on Ash Wednesday.
- Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting. Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 are to eat only one full meal and two others meals consisting of substantially less food. There should be no food taken between meals. Anyone whose health is threatened by fasting is exempted. Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence from meat. Everyone 14 years or older must refrain from eating meat.
- Mondays of Lent Holy Spirit will have Adoration from 5:00-6:00 p.m.(Fr. Ken will also be available for confession during this time). Mass at 6:00 p.m. with Stations of the Cross and a soup supper to follow. The Catholic Daughters will be in charge of lining up the soup with a sign-up sheet available if you would like to help. A free-will offering is taken with money going to Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl collection.
- Rice Bowls are available in the back of church. By using your Rice Bowl we pray together; Fast in solidarity with those who hunger; Learn about the challenges in the lives of our brothers and sisters around the world and give sacrificial contributions to support those in need.
- We have purchased the Little Black Book again this year and they are available in the back of church. This prayer book will walk you through your journey of Lent. There are some copies available in Spanish.
- Fr. Halbur will be the guest speaker at the Union County Lenten Ecumenical Service on Sunday, March 5th, 5:00 p.m., at Salem Lutheran Church (602 W. Townline).

Unfinished Business: No updates on the Old ReRun building or new information on the status of the addition to the school. We are in need of a chair (or co-chairs) for the Food Fair scheduled for September. New Business: none. Committee Reports: Building, Safety and Grounds: The light to the church parking lot needs to be adjusted to correspond with dusk/evening hours; Mark Ide has been contacted to work on the railing to the altar. Family Life: Coffee and rolls served on February 19th. No coffee and rolls in March. Newcomer Michael Brennan has been visited. Social Concerns: The committee will serve Open Table on March 28th. The Food Pantry continues to grow. Liturgy: Committee will meet on February 28th to decorate for Lent and meet March 9th to finalize plans for Holy Week and Easter. Ash Wednesday Mass times are set for 9:15 at school, noon at the Church, and 7:00 p.m. at the church with Religious Education students handling the majority of the ministries. Kelsey Bailey is organizing a Fish Fry March 24th at St. Malachy School. Finance: Last meeting was in January and we are at 73% of our Diocesan Capital Campaign which end in 2018. 
