

FROM FR. KEN

Did you know that there are 41 windows in the rectory? I knew that you were curious about this. How do I know this, because a couple of times a year I take a bottle of widow cleaner and paper towels and clean them all. Sometimes after I do this I walk into the kitchen and am startled because I notice something outside so much more clearly or the lights outside are brighter, the dirt on the window that was blocking the view is gone. Also, if I have not done a good job cleaning them, there are a bunch of streaks or spots on them still and they really stand out, especially if the sun is shining on them. The same thing goes with our spiritual lives. We sometimes do not notice how dirty things are getting until we look at them and the after we have cleaned them. Sometimes I hear in confession, "well father, I don't think I did anything wrong" or "I can't think of anything that I have done." If either of these are the case, spend some time praying with a good examination of conscience, you can find many of them with a simple web search, and I would guarantee that you will come up with something. The intention of the Sacrament of Confession is not to make us feel bad, but for us to let go of those wrongs that we have done to God and to others, for us to clean the windows of our soul, so that we can see more clearly again. So we can refocus and see the light of Christ shining brightly in our lives. When we have done an incomplete confession and we leave the streaks and spots there, when we focus on Christ, those get in the way. When we have had a good confession, it can be refreshing and satisfying.


