

FROM FR. KEN

As St Malachy begins its 146th school year I was thinking about what was going on in the world when it started in 1870. It was during the pontificate of Pope Pius IX, under Bishop John Hennessy of the Dubuque Diocese and at that time, and the First Vatican Council was going on. Something else interesting is that there were 37 states in the United States of America and the President was Ulysses S Grant. In the first year of St Malachy School, the last three states (Virginia, Mississippi, and Texas) were readmitted to the Union after the Civil War, the 15th amendment was ratified, the first motion picture was shown to a theater audience, and the US National Weather Service is created by the US Army. This kind of puts things in perspective doesn't it? We have a long history of Catholic education here in Creston with the school and it is wonderful to be able to continue this long tradition this year. The person credited with beginning the Catholic Education system is Pope Saint Gregory the Great in the late 6th century, but was more informally started by Jesus Christ himself when he told the Disciples to go out to the nations and preach the Gospel, which we have been doing since then. As we begin the school year for St Malachy, Creston public, and East Union, remember to always include learning about the most important thing that we can, and that is about our own faith. Jesus Christ came to bring us the Good News of our salvation, and while learning about the things of the world are great and good for our lives on earth, we need to be also aware of making sure that we know and care about the things that can bring us to eternal life with the Father.


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FOOD PANTRY HAS NEW LOCATION

The Food Pantry that was located at the UCC Church, 501 W. Montgomery, has moved to it's new location! The Creston Area Food Pantry will distribute food from 417 Wyoming Ave. (the former Assembly of God Church) in the lower level. Frozen food, dairy products, dry goods and produce will be provided to recipients from 12 noon to 2:00 p.m. every Sunday. During this transition to the new location, the Creston Area Food Pantry is fiscally operating under Holy Spirit Church until this fall when the pantry will apply for its own 501c3 status. At this time, contributions to the food pantry may be made in the name of "Holy Spirit Needy Fund."

Other business at the Parish Council Meeting: The Council voted (in agreement with the Finance Council) to place the old ReRun Building for sale (with a 30 to 45 day limit) for \$1.00 to have it moved. If the building is not sold, the building will be salvaged, and then torn down. Discussed RAGBRAI and the upcoming Food Fair on September 11th. An addition to St. Malachy School was discussed and a Capital Campaign will be held to raise funds along with grants. Getting a hand railing installed on the altar was discussed. The Family Life Committee will have Coffee and Rolls on October 16th after Mass. Father is working with Catholic Charities to get more mental health care in the Creston region. School will begin August 24th with a projected enrollment of 158 students. Religious Education will begin September 14th for grades 1-8.
