

#### FROM FR. KEN

With school starting we see it now as the end of the summer. So how did it go? Was it busy? Did we get everything done that we wanted to? I know that I did not. I still have a few summer things that I want to get done, but have not gotten to. We sometimes have the best of intentions, but then the other things come up and we get our plans derailed. Sometimes, the things that interrupt our plans are much more important, like the time that we get to spend with a friend who needs something, or a sick family member, but other times we just end up wasting time watching crazy cat videos on the internet. While there is an entertainment value of watching stupid pet videos, they can sometimes distract us from doing what we really need to be doing. One of my downfalls is "just one more episode on Netflixs", or just one more part of a movie, but I know that there may be something more important that I need to do. One of the things that we should always make time for is time with God. In the Gospels, Jesus often goes away to pray with the Father and we should use His example for us to follow. Take that 5 minutes after we wake up to ask God what you need to be doing in the day. I will often spend a couple of minutes in prayer while the coffee is brewing. Our prayer times do not need to be full Holy Hours, while it is wonderful if we could do a Holy Hour every day, we know that it does not always work out that way. What if we decided to do a Holy Five. Pick a time of the day and spend Five minutes with God each and every day, then let that time grow in our hearts.
