

#### FROM FR. KEN

This weekend we are doing a second collection for the annual seminarian appeal drive. The money we collect will go to help offset some of the education costs for the diocese. For any of you who have kids in college or were recently in college, you know what the costs are. Most colleges that have seminaries give a discount to those who are studying to be priests, but the costs are still quite high, and can be in excess of \$35,000 a year including room and board. Just as an example, for me alone, my education costs were about \$170,000 for the seven years I was in school and the diocese covered most of that cost. The seminary process is not an easy one with all of the extra stuff that you need to do while in seminary, it is not just school and study. In the two different seminaries I was in, we averaged 15 -20 hours a week in the extra required things above and beyond classes and homework. Now mind you some of that time is Mass and prayer times, but it made it difficult to do something other than a simple work-study job. Sometimes I hear about trend to have missionary priests fill in at parishes, but this is not a new trend, the only difference is where they are coming from. When our diocese first started, a third of our priests were born in Ireland, a third's parents were born in Ireland, and the other third were from Germany. Now our missionary priests are from India, Kenya, Uganda, Ghana, El Salvador, and other places. One of the questions I often ask people, is when was the last vocation from the parish? Encouraging young men to consider going to seminary to just try it out is the first step, the next one is to support and pray for them.


## **COMING OCTOBER 17TH**


