

### FROM FR. KEN

The words "Pop Quiz" can bring panic in some students, and maybe even bring a flash back to some of us who have been out of school for a while. When I was in my last year of seminary, one of the professors took joy in walking past a fourth theology student would sometimes ask you "recite the prayer of absolution." His rational was it is a prayer that every priest must know immediately and always because you never know when someone will ask for a confession. I myself have heard confessions in a car, in a park, and in an airport. The reasoning behind a pop quiz or the professor who would like to ask for the prayer of absolution is because there are some things that we just need to be prepared for. The police and military train for different situations that may or may not ever happen, why, because there is a possibility that they might and they want to be ready for them. The same should be true for our faith life, what if the pop quiz we run into is the end of our life? What if it is to answer for the things we have done or not done in our lives? Would we be ready for the judgment of God? This is something that we do not often want to think about, but so many times Jesus reminds us that we must be ready because at an unknown hour the Lord will come. To make sure that we are ready for a pop guiz in school, we study, and to keep us ready for the pop quiz of life is to be ready all the time, to do a good daily examination of conscious, to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation often, to pray each and every day, and to be that follower of Christ.

The church cushions will be recovered thanks to memorials from Coletta Bradley and Roberta Ambrose and a parishioner. Yearly dues of \$10 will soon be collected. The Council voted to give Father \$200 for his upcoming trip to Europe. Food Fair: Preliminary reports look similar to last year's. Everything went well. Old ReRun: Building is for sale to be moved for \$1.00. Will be on the market a few more weeks. Capital Campaign: When plans have been finalized and costs received, a Capital Campaign will begin for the addition to the school. The addition would provide safety for all students (all under one roof) and make our preschool program a much more desirable program. Building Grounds and Safety: Church railings are being worked on.
