

FROM FR. KEN

With Pope Francis in the United States, it is bringing a lot of media attention to the Catholic Faith as well as on the Holy Father. I keep seeing stories floating around with something like "Who Pope Francis Is." So many people are enamored by him and want to know more about him. Much of the Catholic media and blogosphere are having a heyday as well and a positive thing is that people are looking into the faith, hopefully at good and orthodox places. One thing that did catch my eye was an article about one of the Popes favorite devotions, Our Lady, the Undoer of Knots. This is a relatively new devotion, only a little more than 300 years old. It stems from an anonymously painted image of Mary untying knots surrounded by angels, but inspired from a meditation from St.Irenaeus who made a comparison between Mary and Eve "Eve, by her disobedience, tied the knot of disgrace for the human race; whereas Mary, by her obedience, undid it." The purpose of the devotion is to offer the knots that we have in our lives to her so she can help us to untie them so that we can be more able to approach her Son. Remember Mary's entire role in humanity is to bring Christ to us and us to Christ. The Pope became aware of this devotion before he became a bishop or the Pope while he was studying for his doctoral degree in Germany. He was undergoing a personal crisis and prayed the devotion and Our Lady guided him through it, since then he has had a love for this particular devotion. One of the great beauties of the Catholic Church, is that we have a vast number of ways to pray, find a devotion that fits your needs and style so that it can help you draw closer to our Lord and Savior.


