

I have received hundreds of offers to help someone process millions of dollars from dying or deceased relatives in Africa. A good number of computer viruses come from following the links in emails, even if they seem like they come from people we know. The fact is that we still receive hundreds of them a week, because it is easy to send them, it costs the sender very little, and they sometimes work. The whole reason that they work is because they appeal to our pride and desire. The senders of the emails attack our pride and desire from different ways, some from the material aspect, "all you have to do is to respond to this email and I will deposit a portion of the \$25 million that my husband left me into your bank account." Some of these emails tug at our body image, "you can lose weight or enhance your body if you follow this link." Some work at our emotions, they ask if you are lonely and need a friend or a "friend", just respond and the most beautiful person in the world will come running after you. All of us want to be happy and successful in different ways and these emails go after those different ways. We have a natural desire to be happy and getting something off the internet is not going to help us to be happy. We can be truly happy by following our faith in Jesus Christ and by fostering those good relationships on earth that can draw us closer to God, that is something that no junk email can give us.


PILGRIMAGE TO IRELAND


