

FROM FR. KEN

Happy Easter!

We have spent the last six weeks preparing ourselves for the coming of the Lord again in the resurrection. What a beautiful and wondrous season. Easter is the time in which we celebrate that the tomb, death, could not hold Jesus our Lord and Savior. He was dead and in the tomb for three days and then he rose from the dead. He has shown us the way, because He is the way, the truth, and the life. One of the things I have witnessed is the ability of Americans to take a holiday and turn it into something different than what it was intended. 


