

# FROM FR. KEN:

Merry Christmas! We began the Christmas season in the Church this week and we will celebrate it until January 10<sup>th</sup> which is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. We also celebrate this week the Feast of Mary the Mother of God on January 1st or New Years Day. It is a day in which we remember Mary's role in the life of her Son, Jesus Christ. We often celebrate secular New Years Day with promises or resolutions like, "New Year, New Me." But often the new year's resolutions only last a few weeks, the gyms are full for the first few weeks of the year, but then attendance drops off pretty quickly. 
