

FROM FR. KEN

This week we will again be celebrating Catholic Schools Week. Sunday morning the students and teachers of St. Malachy School will be performing the ministries at the 9:00 Mass. Within the Catholic Church we have had a long tradition of educating children as well as adults. The title often used for Jesus was Rabbi, which means teacher and one of the things that He did was to teach us about the Father. This has been a mission of the Catholic Church for two thousand years with formal Catholic schools for many hundreds of years. Currently there are over 1.9 million students in a Catholic Elementary School in the United States and over 32 million worldwide. To put that number in perspective, that means 17% of all students in the world go to a Catholic school. In Creston, we have had St. Malachy School since 1870 so, 148 years of Catholic education, and that is quite a long time, but the Church has educated people for much longer. The first Catholic school in the United States was opened in 1606 by Franciscan missionaries. Education has been the mission of the Church ever since Jesus walked the earth. Remember he commands us to go out to all the nations and preach the Gospel. While a school is not the primary mission of the Catholic Church it helps us with our primary goal and that is to bring all people to Christ and thus to heaven. I often hear that it is too expensive for families to send their children to Catholic school, but there are many resources available for help. One of the great programs is Catholic Tuition Organization which gives scholarships based on need. However, a family of 4 making less than \$72,750 a year qualifies for at least some assistance. Our families received about \$37,000 last year to help pay for Catholic education, so there is help available for anyone who would like it.
