

FROM FR. KEN

This week we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, or the Body of Christ. It is one in which we specifically focus on what the Eucharist is. As we receive the Body and Blood of our Savior, what do we think? Are we in awe of the sacrifice He made for us in giving Himself to us or reminded of how blessed we are to be able to receive our Savior, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. This is the feeling that we should all have as we go up and receive the Sacred Eucharist. Sometime though we are distracted and we are not thinking of the blessings that we are receiving, but of breakfast that we are going to, or the 27 games we have to go to this weekend, or how can they wear that? It is easy to get distracted as we celebrate the Mass, there are sometimes children making noise, there are people wearing good/bad outfits, there are friends and family members or people we can't stand in the pews as we pass by, there are good/bad singers that we pass, the list can go on and on. I know how sometimes things can be distracting, remember I am looking out at all of you when I am doing my homily! The key thing that we need to remember is that when we catch ourselves in the distractions, we need to move beyond them and refocus on what is really important and what is the real reason that we are coming to Mass... Jesus! When we come up for Holy Communion, it is not a continuation of the sign of peace, where we greet everyone as we come up or go back, it is a prayerful, holy, and blessed time. We get to receive the Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior, how wonderful is that! Take some time today to remind yourself of this great gift.

Annual Diocesan Appeal Report as of May 25th: St. Edward: 98% of goal


Holy Spirit: 94% of goal

MISSION APPEAL FOR THE DIOCESE OF KOTTAPURAM
