

FROM FR. KEN

This week we break out the rose or pink vestments again as a celebration that we really do rejoice in the Lenten season, even through our fasting. This Sunday is called Laetare Sunday from the entrance antiphon which states Laetare Jerusalem or rejoice O Jerusalem, it comes from the Psalm "Rejoice, O Jerusalem: and come together all you that love her: rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow: that you may exult, and be filled from the breasts of your consolation. I rejoiced at the things that were said to me: we shall go into the house of the Lord...". Our celebration of Laetare Sunday is to give us hope through our fasting. So, how is the fasting going? Is it getting easier or harder? The purpose of fasting is to increase our self control so we can be better at moving away from sin. We rejoice in our self control because it really does lead us to freedom. When we are slaves to an addiction, no matter what it is, whether it be gossip, alcohol, drugs, pornography, or anything else, the addiction does not give us the freedom to live our lives as we should, we are slaves. Currently the number one addiction is pornography and it is affecting kids younger and younger. The building of our self control leads us to the true freedom that God wants us to have, so we can rejoice, even in our suffering. We also know that we are not in this alone. Christ himself was tempted and he overcame the temptation as an example for us. He himself suffered and he accepted that suffering also for us. We can overcome temptation, suffering, and death with His help. Lent is really a beautiful time of the year because of all of the opportunities to grow in our faith as we prepare for the upcoming Easter season.


- March 23rd, 5:30-7:00 p.m., at St. Malachy School. Menu: Fried cod, baked potato, coleslaw, dessert and drink.
