

### FROM FR. KEN

I recently have gotten a couple of questions. The first is why don't I go down to the people to shake hands at the sign of peace? There are two reasons for this, first of all, the Eucharist has already been consecrated and is on the altar, but the Eucharistic prayer is not finished until the priest consumes the Precious Body and Precious Blood. Not recommended to leave the altar during the Eucharistic prayer. The second reason I have already extended a sign of peace to all of the people in the congregation when I say, "the peace of the Lord be with you always." And you to me when you respond "And with your Spirit." So, there is no need to go out to offer another sign of peace to others, even though under special circumstances it can be done. The second question I have gotten is why I do not genuflect when I go to the tabernacle to get the Eucharist during Mass but do as I put the ciborium with the Eucharist back into the tabernacle after Communion? We generally genuflect when we approach the Sacred Elements of the Eucharist in both the Body and Blood, this is why we genuflect before we go into the pew at Mass, we are giving reverence for the Holy Eucharist inside the tabernacle. At the time of the reception of Holy Communion, I have the Body and Blood consecrated at the front altar when I turn to the tabernacle in the high altar. So, when I turn, I am turning away from one set of the Eucharist to the Eucharist in the tabernacle and thus I do not need to genuflect because both the Eucharist that I have just consecrated and the Eucharist in the tabernacle are the same. But when I put them back into the tabernacle I genuflect before I go and sit down again. Thanks for the questions!

*Question for Adults:* Name one area in your life that you need to let go of, to die to, in order to rise with new life.


