

FROM FR. KEN

We have had a couple of busy weekends. Last weekend we had First Communion and this weekend we have both Mother's Day and the sacrament of Confirmation. Both of theses great sacraments are important milestones in the lives of our children and young adults. First Communion is wonderful because our little ones receive the Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior for the first time. Confirmation is beautiful because these young adults confirm their faith in Jesus Christ and His Church. Sometimes Confirmation is referred to becoming an adult in the Church, and in some ways that it true, but in other ways it is not. It is being an adult because they will be taking the responsibility of their faith upon themselves but it is not because Confirmation is simply the confirming of their Baptismal promises. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states "For 'by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence, they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed." This weekend we pray that these young people will accept the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We pray that God will continue to guide them and that we will continue to allow ourselves to be guided by the Holy Spirit, so we can spread and defend the faith by our words and deeds. The prayer that will be said to them sums up what they are to receive. "All-powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit you freed your sons and daughters from sin and gave them new life. Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgment and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence."


CATHOLIC YOUTH CAMP

SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATION

The STO scholarship program helps thousands of Iowa families attend non-public schools each year. The STO pays for itself and then saves the state more than \$12 million a year due to students attending non -public schools. The STP program has not been expanded since 2013. An expansion from \$12 million to \$20 million annually would help thousand more Iowa families make the educational choice that best fits their families' needs. The expansion would also continue to bring further savings to the state budget.
