

FROM FR. KEN

This Sunday we celebrate the "Birthday of the Church," Pentecost. It is called the birthday because it is the day in which we celebrate the Holy Spirit coming down upon the heads of the Apostles. We hear that the disciples receive the gift of the Holy Spirit enabling them to go and preach the Gospel to all people and to baptize them. The Holy Spirit was sent upon the Apostles to give them the wisdom, courage, and understanding that they needed to continue to fulfill the mission that Christ Jesus Himself started. While the Holy Spirit was sent directly on the heads of the Apostles, we receive that same gift of the Holy Spirit when we are confirmed, this means that we are also being called to fulfill Jesus' mission. The mission of preaching the Gospel or Good News. Jesus came to found a Church and to use that Church to bring all people home to the Father in Heaven. Often times we hear the phrase "sola scriptura" or Scripture alone, but the problem with this is that Jesus did not come to give us a book, He came to be with us, to live our lives, to die our deaths, to give us an example to follow and most importantly, to give us a Church and a mission. The mission to follow Him and His message to the Kingdom of Heaven with the Father. He could have easily come down from Heaven and said, here is the book you need to read and follow, and you will be OK, but He didn't, He came to show us the path we are to follow. While He knew that He would not be with us corporally for eternity, he sent the Holy Spirit to continue to be the guide for the Apostles and us, and then sends us to follow that path with the guidance of that same Holy Spirit.
