Though a rather simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your **active membership** and is essential for participation in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership**: three points determine active membership:

- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and resources as means permit.

"I wonder what that collection's for?"

There are several parish/community-centered 2nd collection envelopes members of the parish will see almost every month, i.e., Parish Hall, Share Sunday, and Repairs and Improvement Fund. Have you ever wondered what they are for or how the money is distributed? Here is a brief explanation of how the parish allocates these donations. Parish Hall is a once-a-month collection that helps pay the non-interest bearing mortgage payments for both the Parish Social Hall--which is used for many of our classes and social events, and the land purchased by Good Shepherd for St. Isidore's new church as part of our daughter parish responsibilities. We ask each family to donate \$10.00 a month towards these mortgage payments. Share Sunday is also a once-a-month collection that is distributed to several charities and social organizations within the local area. The current recipients of Share Sunday donations are the ALMS House (12%), Hope House (12%), Save the Babies (12%), St. Isidore's Mission (33%), CARE Clinic (12%) and St. Ann's Catholic School (19%). The list of recipients and the distribution percentage is reviewed and adjusted by the Parish Council annually. Donations of food and other items are distributed to the ALMS House and Catholic Charities. The Repairs and Improvement collection comes almost every month and helps primarily to defray the costs of improvements for our Church, Social Hall and grounds. This includes special targeted donations for specific improvements.
