PLANNING TO HAVE YOUR CHILD

BAPTIZED? Following are answers to questions often asked: PARENTS



1. Parent(s) must be registered in Good Shepherd Parish for a minimum of 90



- days before the Baptism can be celebrated. 2. Parent(s) must attend the parish Baptismal
- Preparation Sessions or have proof of attendance from another parish. All parent(s) are required to attend the Second Session even if they have attended baptismal preparation previously.
- 3. Parents do not have to be married in the Catholic Church to have their child baptized in the parish.
- 4. It is not required that both parents be Catholic.
- 5. We do baptize the children of a single parent.
- 6. Parents may not serve as godparents to their own children.

GODPARENTS

- 1. The godparent(s) must be at least 18 years of age,
- have received the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, 2. Confirmation & Eucharist,
- 3. in a marriage recognized by the Church as valid, if married.
- 4. living a life consistent with a single person as defined by the Church, if unmarried, i.e. not "living with" someone.
- 5. a Catholic in good standing, i.e. attends Mass and participates in the sacramental life of the Church,
- 6. attend a Baptismal Preparation Class either at Good Shepherd or their parish.

If the godparent(s) is/are not registered in Good Shepherd Parish, they must present a statement from their parish indicating they are in full communion with the Catholic Church and can stand as godparent(s). The statement must be presented to the parish at least one week before the date of Baptism. At least one godparent must meet the above criteria. Each child should have one male and one female godparent. It is acceptable to have only one godparent, however, this practice is not encouraged.

PROXIES

1. Proxies, those who stand in for the godparents, MUST also meet the above requirements.

CHRISTIAN WITNESSES

1. A person from a non-Catholic Christian denomination may serve as a Christian witness together with a Catholic godparent. The Christian witness must be a member in good standing in his/her denomination.


